2009-2010 PRESIDENT'S AWARD















To earn the Texas-Louisiana Division President's Award for Fiscal Year 2009-2010, a Chapter must fulfill the five required items and at least five additional items during the period July 1, 2009 through April 15, 2010.

Five (5) required items:

-  Sign the Chapter of Excellence Commitment Agreement
-  Receive recertification points for a minimum of seven chapter meetings
-  Hold a minimum of one IMPACT Meeting
-  Submit an application to the Avery Chapter Achievement Award
-  Submit New Officers listing to HQ and Division Secretary by July 1st

Choose at least five (5) from the following items:

-  Publish a regular chapter newsletter or maintain a chapter website
-  Create and maintain an annual budget and provide a monthly financial statement to the chapter membership
-  Conduct a New Member Orientation Program (for members with less than one year membership)
-  All officers and committee chairmen attend one of the Division Officer Training Workshops
-  Sponsor a New Chapter or new Student Chapter
-  Sponsor a CPS/CAP Study Group (along or with another chapter)
-  Sponsor a Scholarship Award
-  Recruit one new Associate Member
-  Hold a Professional Development Seminar (half day or all day)
-  Hold an Executive / Employer Awareness Program
-  Nominate a Company for the Award of Excellence
-  Have a Division Officer present a program to your chapter
